Students who are studying in Germany can go to abroad for internship up to 6 months. But you can not leave the country more than 6 months. For Austria you don't need work permit but you need visa type D for internship for more than 3 months. You can apply embassies outside of the austria. Munchen and Bratislava embassies are the options and with erasmus+ programme after application to the embassy you can collect your visa in the same week.
