- Build front-end tools (Access, Excel VBA) for business users to improve working performance, reduce manual tasks;

- Monitor day to day operations of the daily schedule tasks to debug and fix issues on a timely manner

I have a direct team lead who mentored and assigned tasks for me. Since I work from home most of the time, so I try to as proactive as I can in trying to learn and finish the tasks as good as I can by do not hesitate to ask the questions and set up the meeting with other members in team to ask for the traning on the parts that are new to me.

The working condition is okie for me, I was provided with all necessary equipments required for my job at home
