I join the company's data mining and business intelligence unit. During my internship, I help to provide support in decision making and internal reporting, help to create data visualizations. Besides, I help to develop of existing and new machine learning solutions (modeling, feature engineering), I participate in creation of research documents, gather and present academic information on topics relevant to the receiving organization's current projects. I also help in data collection, processing and analysis.

I had one mentor directly giving tasks and help me while I was doing research or have any struggle. The working conditions was good, the office placed in the heart of Budapest with well-developed public transportation system. Small negative experience was from the language barrier so I didn't feel comfortable while I sick and need to visit doctors.

I gain my skills in domain-specific experience with Python and R programming language. I learned to effective collaboration on code development with team members through git version control system. Besides, I also gain on various soft skills such as presentation skills, teamwork, time management
